School Uniform Policy

Supplier:

- Our uniform provider is Perry Uniform and the full uniform list for boys and girls can be found at: www.perryuniform.co.uk/online/Kew-House-School.html
- This includes full PE and Games Kit. Team strips for specific sports will be provided for students.

Policy:

- The school has high expectations for our students' dress code. They will be required to conform to the standards we prescribe both in and out of school.
- Students must arrive in school and journey home in full uniform.
- Students should not arrive or depart wearing Sports kit.
- The uniform signifies the students are representing the school.
 Students must be smartly turned out on sports fixtures, where possible arriving in uniform. Where deemed appropriate by staff students may return in kit but with their blazers worn over kit at all times.
- A gum shield/guard and personal protective wear, shin guards and cricket box must be provided for games lessons and fixtures. It is the responsibility of each student to bring these to session and failure to do so may preclude them participating in an activity on the grounds of safety.
- In school students must wear their full uniform at all times. Ties must cover the top button and neither worn long or too short. The three logos must be clearly visible.
- Blazers may be removed in class but students must wear blazers when not in class, even when
 released from session to use the toilets for example. There will be a relaxing of this in a summer
 dress code for hot days. Students will be advised when this is in operation.
- Short sleeve shirts are available from Perry Uniform and can be worn in the summer term only.
- All students should wear dark blue socks. Blue tights are the only colour permitted.
- Clip on ID badges are provided by Kew House School and should be worn at all times in school.
 Students will receive one new ID badge every year. Additional badges will be charged for. ID badges may be removed for the journey to and from school.
- Overalls will be provided for practical subjects such as Art, DT and Science, to protect uniform.
 Other specialist items of protective wear will be provided by the school for these subjects. Full uniform must be worn for these sessions and PE kit is not acceptable or safe.
- Please label all items of property with your child's name.

Hair, makeup and jewellery:

- Students may wear a necklace under their uniform. This must be removed for PE/Games. A single plain stud earing may be worn in each ear. Multiple ear and other piercings are not acceptable.
- Rings are not permitted in Y7 and 8 and a single ring may be worn in Year 9, 10 and 11.
- Students may be requested to remove these where safety is an issue, for example in Science, DT, Food Tech or PE. The school will not accept any responsibility for the loss or damage of these items.
- Makeup is not permitted in Y7 and 8. In other year groups students wearing excessive makeup will be asked to remove it. Lipstick is not permitted. Nail varnish must not be worn.
- Long hair must be tied back at all times. Headbands must be of a single dark colour.
 Patterned or decorative haircuts or eyebrows are not acceptable.

Footwear

• All students should wear polished leather shoes.

Boys may wear **gloss brown**, boat or brogue style **polished shoe** (no suede or contrasting soles). Laces must be tied or tucked in for safety.

Girls may wear either **gloss brown or blue** leather or leather style **polished** shoes. Ballet style or light court shoes are **not** acceptable on safety grounds. **Black shoes are not permitted.**
