

GCSE grades analysis- Kew House school.

Context. This cohort of 32 students joined the school from September 2013 (12 in September 2013) or later. The profile of students at Kew House is mixed ability with students in the 2016 and 2017 cohorts demonstrating a wide spectrum of ability. Some subjects had significant numbers of low ability students which resulted in a lower percentage of high grades. Students study the core subject plus four optional subjects. The numbers of candidates in each subject may vary considerably.
